Energy Star Appliances

- Refrigerator - \$50 (with recycling of old fridge)
- Refrigerator - \$20 (without recycling of old fridge)
- Dishwasher - \$25
- Clothes washer - \$50
- Dehumidifier - \$10
- Ceiling fan - \$25
- Clothes dryer (electric only) - \$80
- Room air conditioner - \$25
- LED screw in bulb - \$3 per bulb
- LED recessed can fixture or retrofit kit - \$4 per fixture
- CFL screw in bulb - \$1.50 per bulb

Heating Cooling and Ventilation

- Central air conditioner ≤5 tons – \$250 (Energy Star, minimum 14.5 SEER)
- Central air conditioner ≤5 tons – \$350 (Energy Star, minimum 18.0 SEER)
- Mini split/ ductless air conditioner – \$250 (minimum 16.0 SEER)
- Furnace with ECM - \$150
- Air handler/fan coil with ECM - \$150
- Air source heat pump - \$250 (Energy Star, minimum 14.5 SEER, 8.2 HSPF)
- Air source heat pump - \$350 (minimum 18.0 SEER, 9.5 HSPF)
- Mini split/ductless air source heat pump - \$250 (minimum 16.0 SEER)
- Geothermal heat pumps - \$200 per ton (see application for more details)
- Programmable thermostat - \$25 (must control central air conditioning)

Water Heating

- Heat pump water heater - \$100 (Energy Star, EF ≥ 2.0)
- Monthly \$2 credit for controlled water heating (minimum 50 gal. tank)
- High efficient electric water heaters – up to \$150 (minimum .91 EF and 8 year tank warranty)

Off Peak Heating

- Special 4.9¢ per kWh electric rate
- Must have backup fossil fuel system or storage heat capacity

Appliance Turn In Program (annually, spring)

- Working refrigerator - \$35
- Working freezer - \$35
- Room air conditioner - \$25 (must accompany refrigerator or freezer)
- Check with Detroit Lakes Public Utilities for pick up dates

New Home Programs

- Energy star refrigerator - \$50 rebate
- CFL light bulbs - 12 free CFL's per new home
